

# TNReady Timeline

## Preparation for 2016-17 Assessments

### August

- *End of Aug.:* Standards setting process with educators completed for 2015-16 TNReady high school EOC tests

### October

- *Oct. 10-14:* State Board of Education meeting on cut scores for 2015-16 TNReady high school EOC tests
- *Mid-Oct.:* Regional trainings for district and school personnel to learn the online platform
- *Late Oct.:* State-level high school results released from 2015-16 TNReady high school EOC tests

### December

- *Early Dec.:* New and improved State Report Card goes live
- *Dec.:* TVAAS restricted site available

### September

- Practice tests available for educators for 2016-17 TNReady math, ELA, and U.S. history
- *Sept. 29:* Online pilot with select districts to test new online platform

### November

- *Early Nov.:* Local high school results from 2015-16 school year shared with districts
- *Early Nov.:* Educator evaluation from 2015-16 school year completed
- *Early Nov.:* Online practice tests for 2016-17 TNReady math, ELA, and social studies available for high school students
- *Nov.:* Online demonstration site available for parents and the public to see sample high school test questions for 2016-17 TNReady
- *Late Nov.:* High school student score reports available to educators and families from 2015-16 testing
- *Late Nov.:* Raw score data for grades 3-8 from 2015-16 school year shared with schools; parents can ask to see how their student performed

### January and February

- Additional regional trainings for district and school personnel to learn the online platform

### March-May

- *March:* Social studies field test
- *March-May:* TCAP-Alt and MSA
- *April-May:* TNReady testing
